Math

Over the past week we focused on data management and have been able to look at bias in a survey and understand what it means to have biased results. Students were asked to create two survey questions, collect the data, transfer the data to a spreadsheet, create a graph that appropriately displays the date and finally draw conclusions based on their data. They were asked to hand that in via Google Classroom today.

Looking ahead... we will spend some time looking at misleading graphs and link it to media literacy and take a brief look at "fake news".

Music (EMF7B)

This week we focused on "Hot Cross Buns" and worked on songs that included the first 5 notes. Students were told that they can either play their music test (#18) this Tuesday or the following Tuesday - a bit of flexibility for the first test :o) All students were encouraged to take their instruments home to practice. Looking ahead... Students will have their first playing test (#18 - "Hot Cross Buns") on either on November 12th OR November 19th - their choice!

English

Over the past week students have reviewed making connections and read a story about carrier pigeons in WW2. They worked on reading strategy #3, visualizing, and completed a task using articles from the "Canada Remembers Times". Looking ahead... students will hand in their carrier pigeon assignment in Google Classroom and watch a movie connecting to what they have read. Later in the week they will be looking at "fake news" as it links to graphs in math.
