Math

Over the past week we learned about supplementary and complementary angles, transversal lines, opposite angles, alternate angles, corresponding angles and co-interior angles. Today, did a bit of sleuth work and students had to "think outside the box" and these angles to help us find missing angle Looking ahead... we will measurements. review the sum of the angles in a triangle and have two quizzes (one online and one pencil and paper) next week to check for understanding. All area tests have been handed back - I asked students to have them signed and returned. Some students will need to meet with me at recesses and review measurement and complete extra practice before rewriting the measurement test to show me that they have a clear understanding of the difference between area and perimeter.



This week students were excited to play "Let's Go Band" and we continued to look at a new note. We also started to learn the B-flat concert scale. Looking ahead... we will continue to work through the method book and push to learn our next two notes.

English

Over the past week students spent English classes presenting their "Stories of the Decade". Lots and lots of oral presentations going on.
