Math

Over the past two weeks we applied our understanding of angles to find missing measurements of a variety of triangles. We have also used our knowledge of the relationships of sides and angles to draw triangles given three pieces of information. **Looking ahead...** we will finish up our unit in Geometry with some compass work (creating congruent angles and triangles, bisecting angles and creating perpendicular bisectors). I did remind students to bring a compass (or circle drawer as one student put it!) with them this week because I do not have a full class set to share with everyone. We will also have one of two quizzes (one online and one pencil and paper) on Thursday and the other will be the following Monday or Tuesday next week to check for understanding. Our next unit will be number sense and numeration focusing on Fractions.

Music (EMF7B)

This week students did not have music. **Looking ahead...** we will continue to work through the method book and push to learn our next two notes. Please encourage your child to bring home their instrument and play for you. It is always important to play for a supportive audience!

English

Over the past two weeks students were able to listen to each other's story of the decade presentations. They also worked on a collaborative descriptive paragraph and were introduced to a long term reading assignment. Please refer to the email I sent on February 10th for further details. **Looking ahead...** we are taking a break from TUSC and will resume the first week of March. Students will continue to have some time during the week to read for their "Read, Relax & Repeat" reading assignment. Reading for this assignment should be considered homework if they have gotten all of their other work done in class. We will working on writing an information paragraph focusing on topic and concluding sentences.
